AM 2117 strikes the original sections in LB 985. The bill updates Nebraska guardianship and conservatorship law to allow the person who is the subject of the case to attend hearings virtually or in person, permits notice to be provided in alternative formats or with auxiliary aids when needed, authorizes courts to appoint standby guardians and sets a process for a standby guardian to assume duties, limits guardians and conservators from accepting new appointments once they serve twenty individuals, and allows courts to award costs and reasonable attorney's fees in specified proceedings as justice and equity require.

There is no fiscal impact.
