- 1 Section 1. Section 8-126, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 3 8-126 (1) Reasonable efforts shall be made for a A majority of the
- 4 members of the board of directors of any bank <u>to</u> shall have their <u>primary</u>
- 5 residences (a) in this state, (b) or within twenty-five miles of the main
- 6 office of the bank, (c) in . Reasonable efforts shall be made to acquire
- 7 members of such board of directors from the county in which the main
- 8 office of such bank is located, or (d) in and from counties in which
- 9 branches of such bank are located.
- 10 (2) Directors of banks shall be persons of good moral character,
- 11 known integrity, business experience, and responsibility. No person shall
- 12 act as a member of the board of directors of any bank until such bank
- 13 applies for and obtains approval from the department.
- 14 (3) If the department, upon investigation, determines that any
- 15 director of a bank is conducting the business of the bank in an unsafe or
- 16 unauthorized manner or is endangering the interests of the stockholders
- 17 or depositors, the Director of Banking and Finance has the authority,
- 18 following notice and opportunity for hearing, to revoke such approval to
- 19 act as a member of the board of directors.
- 20 (4) The Director of Banking and Finance may adopt and promulgate
- 21 rules and regulations and prescribe forms to carry out this section.
