## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 263**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for
- 2 the payment of the salaries and benefits of certain state officers
- 3 for FY2025-26 and FY2026-27; to define terms; to provide an
- 4 operative date; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.
- There are hereby appropriated, for FY2025-26 and FY2026-27, the
- 3 amounts specified in this act, or so much as may be necessary, for the
- 4 salaries and benefits of officers of the Nebraska state government.
- 5 Sec. 2. DEFINITION OF APPROPRIATION PERIOD.
- 6 For purposes of this act, FY2025-26 means the period beginning July
- 7 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026, and FY2026-27 means the period
- 8 beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027.
- 9 Sec. 3. NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.
- 10 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting System Manual,
- and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk of the Legislature are
- 12 hereby adopted by the Legislature as the definitions for this act, except
- 13 as provided in section 5 of this act.
- 14 Sec. 4. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.
- 15 The Director of Administrative Services shall draw warrants upon the
- 16 proper fund in the state treasury for an amount not to exceed the
- 17 appropriations set forth in this act upon presentation of proper
- 18 documentation. The State Treasurer shall pay the warrants out of the
- 19 appropriate funds.
- 20 Workers' compensation premium assessments shall not be paid from the
- 21 programs listed in this act.
- 22 Sec. 5. LIMITATION ON SALARIES, WAGES, AND PER DIEMS.
- 23 (1) As used in this act:
- 24 (a) SALARY LIMIT means total expenditures for permanent and
- 25 temporary salaries and per diems; and
- 26 (b) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
- 27 diems means all remuneration paid to employees treated as taxable
- 28 compensation by the Internal Revenue Service or subject to social
- 29 security coverage, specifically including payments accounted for as
- 30 vacation, holidays, sick leave, military leave, funeral leave, maternity
- 31 leave, administrative leave, compensatory time, deferred compensation, or

- 1 any other similar form, and amounts withheld pursuant to law, but
- 2 excluding state contributions for social security, retirement, and
- 3 employee insurance plans.
- 4 (2) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
- 5 diems are limited to the amount provided by law for constitutional
- 6 officers.
- 7 (3) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 8 salaries and per diems for FY2025-26 shall be increased by certified
- 9 encumbrance amounts from FY2024-25 for permanent and temporary salaries
- 10 and per diems. The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 11 salaries and per diems for FY2026-27 shall be increased by certified
- 12 encumbrance amounts from FY2025-26 for permanent and temporary salaries
- 13 and per diems. Encumbered amounts shall be calculated in accordance with
- 14 section 81-138.01.
