- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the County Visitors Improvement Fund; to
- amend section 81-3720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 change provisions relating to grants; to repeal the original
- 4 section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 81-3720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 81-3720 (1)(a) The County Visitors Improvement Fund shall be
- 4 administered by the governing body of the county with the advice of the
- 5 visitors committee created pursuant to section 81-3717. The fund shall be
- 6 used to make grants for expanding and improving facilities at any
- 7 existing visitor attraction, acquiring or expanding exhibits for existing
- 8 visitor attractions, constructing visitor attractions, or planning or
- 9 developing such expansions, improvements, or construction.
- 10 (b) Grants shall be available for any visitor attraction in the
- 11 county owned by the public or any nonprofit organization, the primary
- 12 purpose of which is to operate the visitor attraction.
- 13 (c) Grants may be made for a specified annual amount not to exceed
- 14 the greater of the proceeds derived from a sales tax rate of one percent
- 15 imposed by a county for a County Visitors Improvement Fund or five
- 16 thousand dollars. Grants may be made for a term of years not to exceed
- 17 twenty years and may be pledged by the recipient to secure bonds issued
- 18 to finance expansion, improvement, or construction of a visitor
- 19 attraction. Any grant made for a term of years shall be funded each year
- 20 in accordance with any agreement contained in the grant contract.
- 21 (d) No bonds issued by a grant recipient which pledges grant funds
- 22 shall constitute a debt, liability, or general obligation of the county
- 23 levying the tax or a pledge of the faith and credit of the county levying
- 24 the tax but shall be payable solely from grant funds. Each bond issued by
- 25 any grant recipient which pledges grant funds shall contain on the face
- 26 thereof a statement that neither the faith and credit nor the taxing
- 27 power of the county levying the tax is pledged to the payment of the
- 28 principal of or the interest on such bond.
- 29 (2) For purposes of this section and section 81-3717, visitor
- 30 attraction means a defined location open to the public, which location is
- 31 of educational, cultural, historical, artistic, or recreational

- 1 significance or provides entertainment or in which are exhibits,
- 2 displays, or performances of educational, cultural, historic, artistic,
- 3 or entertainment value.
- 4 Sec. 2. Original section 81-3720, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is repealed.
- 6 **Sec. 3.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 7 passed and approved according to law.
