- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the State Procurement Act; to amend section
- 2 73-803, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024; to redefine a
- 3 term; to provide for applicability; to repeal the original section;
- 4 and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

**Section 1.** Section 73-803, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 73-803 For purposes of the State Procurement Act:
- 4 (1) Contract includes any contract for services and contract for
- 5 personal property;
- 6 (2) Contract for personal property means any contract entered into
- 7 by the state with another party for a stated consideration, which
- 8 provides that the state agency is to receive the personal property or use
- 9 of such personal property furnished by the other party. Contract for
- 10 personal property includes leases;
- 11 (3) Contract for services means any contract that directly engages
- 12 the time or effort of an independent contractor whose purpose is to
- 13 perform an identifiable task, study, or report rather than to furnish an
- 14 end item of supply, goods, equipment, or material;
- 15 (4) Cooperative agreement means a legal instrument reflecting a
- 16 relationship between the State of Nebraska and any other entity where (a)
- 17 the principal purpose of the relationship is to transfer a thing of value
- 18 to the entity to carry out a public purpose of support or stimulation by
- 19 law instead of acquiring property or services for the direct benefit of
- 20 the State of Nebraska and (b) substantial involvement is expected between
- 21 the State of Nebraska and the entity when carrying out the activity
- 22 contemplated in the agreement;
- 23 (5) Division means the materiel division of the Department of
- 24 Administrative Services;
- 25 (6) Emergency means necessary to meet an urgent or unexpected
- 26 requirement or when health and public safety or the conservation of
- 27 public resources is at risk;
- 28 (7) Grant agreement means a legal instrument reflecting a
- 29 relationship between the State of Nebraska and any other entity where (a)
- 30 the principal purpose of the relationship is to transfer a thing of value
- 31 to the entity to carry out a public purpose of support or stimulation by

1 law instead of acquiring property or services for the direct benefit of

- 2 the State of Nebraska and (b) substantial involvement is not expected
- 3 between the State of Nebraska and the entity when carrying out the
- 4 activity contemplated in the agreement;
- 5 (8) Occasional means seasonal, irregular, or fluctuating in nature;
- 6 (9) Personal property includes all materials, supplies, furniture,
- 7 equipment, printing, stationery, automotive and road equipment, and other
- 8 chattels, goods, wares, and merchandise;
- 9 (10) Sole source means of such a unique nature that the contractor
- 10 selected is clearly and justifiably the only practicable source to
- 11 provide the service or personal property. Determination that the
- 12 contractor selected is justifiably the sole source is based on either the
- 13 uniqueness of the service or personal property or sole availability at
- 14 the location required;
- 15 (11) State agency means any agency, board, or commission of this
- 16 state, except for the University of Nebraska or the Nebraska state
- 17 colleges. For purposes of procurement of services, state agency does not
- 18 include the University of Nebraska, the Nebraska state colleges, the
- 19 <u>Nebraska Investment Council,</u> the courts, the Legislature, or any officer
- 20 or state agency established by the Constitution of Nebraska. Changes made
- 21 to this subdivision by this legislative bill shall be construed to apply
- 22 to any action taken on or after July 19, 2024; and
- 23 (12) Temporary means a finite period of time with respect to a
- 24 specific task or result relating to a contract for services.
- 25 Sec. 2. Original section 73-803, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 26 Supplement, 2024, is repealed.
- 27 **Sec. 3.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 28 passed and approved according to law.
