- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Dentistry Practice Act; to amend
- 2 sections 38-1117 and 38-1120, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
- 3 to change requirements for licensure and reciprocity as prescribed;
- 4 and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- **Section 1.** Section 38-1117, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 38-1117 (1) Every applicant for a license to practice dentistry
- 4 shall (a) present proof of graduation with a Doctor of Dental Surgery
- 5 degree or a Doctor of Dental Medicine degree from an accredited school or
- 6 college of dentistry, (b) pass an examination approved by the Board of
- 7 Dentistry which shall consist of the <u>Integrated National Board Dental</u>
- 8 <u>Examination or Examinations</u>, both Part I and Part II <u>of the National</u>
- 9 Board Dental Examination, as constructed and administered by the American
- 10 Dental Association Joint Commission on National Dental Examinations, (c)
- 11 demonstrate the applicant's <u>psychomotor</u> skill in clinical dentistry by
- 12 passing <u>a standardized national examination approved by the practical</u>
- 13 examination administered by the Central Regional Dental Testing Service
- 14 or any other regional or state practical examination that the board Board
- 15 of Dentistry determines to be comparable to such practical examination,
- 16 (d) pass a jurisprudence examination approved by the board that is based
- 17 on the Nebraska statutes, rules, and regulations governing the practice
- 18 of dentistry and dental hygiene, and (e) demonstrate continuing clinical
- 19 competency as a condition of licensure if required by the board.
- 20 (2)(a) An examination approved by the board under subdivision (1)(c)
- 21 of this section shall be a simulation-based or manikin-based clinical
- 22 competency psychomotor examination that demonstrates evidence of
- 23 psychometric soundness and shall include (i) a simulation-based or
- 24 <u>manikin-based periodontal component, (ii) a simulation-based or manikin-</u>
- 25 based restorative component, (iii) a simulation-based or manikin-based
- 26 prosthodontic component, (iv) a simulation-based or manikin-based
- 27 <u>endodontic component, and (v) a remediation policy to address candidate</u>
- 28 deficiencies.
- 29 <u>(b) The board may review examinations annually and shall review</u>
- 30 <u>examinations at least every three years.</u>
- 31 (3) (2) Upon completion of these requirements, the department, with

1 the recommendation of the board, shall issue the applicant a license to

- 2 practice dentistry.

- 5 38-1120 Every applicant for a license to practice dentistry based on
- 6 a license in another state or territory of the United States or the
- 7 District of Columbia shall meet the standards set by the board pursuant
- 8 to section 38-126 and shall have been actively engaged in the practice of
- 9 dentistry for at least one year three years, one of which must be within
- 10 the three years immediately preceding the application, under a license in
- 11 another state or territory of the United States or the District of
- 12 Columbia. Practice in an accredited school or college of dentistry for
- 13 the purpose of completing a postgraduate or residency program in
- 14 dentistry also serves as active practice toward meeting this requirement.
