- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public health; to amend sections 28-441 and
- 2 28-442, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024; to provide for
- 3 syringe services programs; to provide for exceptions to penalties
- 4 under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act relating to drug
- 5 paraphernalia; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The governing body of a municipality or county may
- 2 <u>authorize</u>, <u>by ordinance or resolution</u>, <u>a syringe services program to</u>
- 3 operate within the bounds of such municipality or county. A county
- 4 ordinance or resolution shall not be effective within the corporate
- 5 <u>boundaries of any incorporated municipality located in whole or in part</u>
- 6 within the county.
- 7 (2) A syringe services program authorized by this section shall, at
- 8 <u>a minimum, offer or arrange for the provision of the following:</u>
- 9 (a) A needs assessment for program participants;
- 10 (b) Access to sterile syringes, needles, and other items or
- 11 equipment used to reduce the risk of disease transmission or other harm;
- 12 <u>(c) Safe disposal of used syringes, needles, and other items or</u>
- 13 <u>equipment;</u>
- 14 (d) Referral information and educational materials regarding
- 15 substance use disorder prevention and treatment;
- (e) Information to reduce injection and overdose risks;
- 17 (f) Naloxone or information about where naloxone can be obtained at
- 18 low or no cost; and
- 19 (g) Referral information and educational materials regarding social
- 20 services, mental health care, and other health care services.
- 21 (3) A syringe services program authorized by this section shall not
- 22 be located within five hundred feet of any:
- 23 (a) Public or private: Child care facility; elementary, vocational,
- 24 <u>or secondary school; or youth center; or</u>
- (b) Public: Community recreation center, library, or swimming pool.
- 26 (4) A syringe services program authorized by this section shall only
- 27 provide services to individuals eighteen years of age or older.

- 3 (2) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an
- 4 infraction.
- 5 (3) A person shall not be in violation of this section if section
- 6 28-472 or 28-1701 applies.
- 7 (4) This section does not apply to:
- 8 <u>(a) The staff of a syringe services program authorized by section 1</u>
- 9 of this act when such staff are engaged in the provision, retrieval, or
- 10 disposal of syringes, needles, or other items or equipment in connection
- 11 with the program; or
- 12 <u>(b) A participant of such a program when the participant is engaged</u>
- in the retrieval or disposal of syringes, needles, or other items or
- 14 equipment at or within the immediate vicinity of the program site or
- 15 facility.

- 18 28-442 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to deliver, possess
- 19 with intent to deliver, or manufacture with intent to deliver, drug
- 20 paraphernalia, knowing, or under circumstances in which one reasonably
- 21 should know, that it will be used to manufacture, inject, ingest, or
- 22 inhale or otherwise be used to introduce into the human body a controlled
- 23 substance in violation of sections 28-101, 28-431, and 28-439 to 28-444.
- 24 (2) This section shall not apply to:
- 25 (a) Pharmacists pharmacists, pharmacist interns, pharmacy
- 26 technicians, and pharmacy clerks who sell hypodermic syringes or needles
- 27 for the prevention of the spread of infectious diseases; -
- 28 <u>(b) The staff of a syringe services program authorized by section 1</u>
- 29 of this act when such staff are engaged in the provision, retrieval, or
- 30 disposal of syringes, needles, or other items or equipment in connection

- 5 (3) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class
- 6 II misdemeanor.
