1 The State Treasurer shall transfer \$100,000,000 from the Section 1. 2 General Fund to the School District Property Tax Relief Credit Fund on or after July 1, 2025, but before June 30, 2026, on such dates and in such 3 4 amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of 5 the Department of Administrative Services. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$100,000,000 from the 6 Sec. 2. 7 General Fund to the School District Property Tax Relief Credit Fund on or after July 1, 2026, but before June 30, 2027, on such dates and in such 8 9 amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of 10 the Department of Administrative Services. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$100,000,000 from the 11 Sec. 3. School District Property Tax Relief Credit Fund for FY2025-26 and (2) 12 13 \$100,000,000 from the School District Property Tax Relief Credit Fund for FY2026-27 to the Department of Revenue, for Program 121, to aid in 14 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 170, One Hundred Ninth 15 Legislature, First Session, 2025. 16 17 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2025-26 \$100,000,000 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such 18 19 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for

20 FY2026-27 \$100,000,000 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used 21 for such purpose.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
 section.

25 **Sec. 4.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when 26 passed and approved according to law.
