1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND
2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 **Section 1.** At the general election in November 2026, the following
4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

6 To amend Article VI, section 1:

7 **VI-1 Only a** ~~Every~~ citizen of the United States who has attained the
8 age of eighteen years on or before the first Tuesday after the first
9 Monday in November and has resided within the state and the county and
10 voting precinct for the terms provided by law shall, except as provided
11 in section 2 of this article, be an elector for the calendar year in
12 which such citizen has attained the age of eighteen years and for all
13 succeeding calendar years.

14 **Sec. 2.** The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
15 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
16 section 1, with the following ballot language:

17 A constitutional amendment to state that only a United States
18 citizen may be an elector.
