LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 504

Introduced by Murman, 38.

WHEREAS, Pryce Sandfort and Braden Frager are current members of the University of Nebraska men's basketball team and both athletes come from families with deep roots in Nebraska high school basketball; and

WHEREAS, Brian Sandfort, father of Pryce Sandfort, was a standout basketball player at Holdrege High School, and Rick Frager, father of Braden Frager, was a standout basketball player at Sandy Creek High School, both in District 38; and
