## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB110**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB110 prohibits health care providers from performing on any patient who is anesthetized or unconscious without prior written consent. Exceptions are made for: written consent from a person authorized to make healthcare decisions for a patient; the examination is necessary for emergency medical diagnostic or treatment purposes; or a court has ordered the examination for the collection of evidence. A violation of this statute results in discipline under the Uniform Credentialing Act. If a pelvic examination is performed on an anesthetized or unconscious patient they are required to be notified in writing prior to being discharged.
