## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB222 seeks to amend statutes regarding law enforcement's authority to stop, detain, and search vehicles. It limits stops for nonmoving violations or driving under suspension unless a serious warrant exists, and for equipment violations unless they pose an immediate safety threat. Officers must document the reason for the stop beforehand and inform the driver, and questioning or searching is restricted unless there's plain-view evidence of another crime. Vehicle searches require a warrant or written consent.
