Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 383 would establish the Parental Rights in Social Media Act, requiring social media companies to obtain parental consent before allowing a minor to open a social media account.

Additionally, LB 383 would ensure that social media platforms provide parents with oversight tools to monitor and manage their child's account activity. The bill grants enforcement authority to the Nebraska Attorney General, allowing for penalties of up to \$2500.00 per violation. The act would take effect on January 1, 2026.
