## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB975**

**Committee: Government, Military and Veterans Affairs**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 975 adopts the Private Attorney Retention Sunshine Act and applies to contracts between private attorneys and the Attorney General exceeding ten thousand dollars. Under this Act, the Attorney General shall not retain a private attorney or law firm to perform legal services exceeding ten thousand dollars on behalf of the state until an open and competitive bidding process has been undertaken.

At the conclusion of the legal services contract the private attorney or law firm shall provide the Attorney General with a statement of the hours worked, expenses incurred, aggregate fee amount and a breakdown of the hourly rate. In no event shall the state incur legal fees greater than one thousand dollars per hour for legal services. LB 975 also includes a severability clause.
