## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 266**

Approved by the Governor April 7, 2025

Introduced by Dover, 19; Sanders, 45.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to local governments; to prohibit ordinances which have the effect of imposing rent controls on private property; to define terms; to provide limits on such ordinances; and to provide applicability. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:

- (a) Local government means any city, village, or county or any agency or subdivision of a city, village, or county; and
- (b) Ordinance means any local law, including, but not limited to, any ordinance, resolution, rule, or regulation.
- (2) Except as expressly permitted by other state law or by subsection (3) of this section, a local government shall not have the power to enact or enforce any ordinance which would have the effect of imposing rent controls on private property.
  - (3) This section does not apply to an ordinance that:
- (a) Is adopted for the purposes of increasing the supply of affordable housing and that does so through land-use or inclusionary housing requirements; or
- (b) Provides for a program that a private property owner voluntarily and contractually agrees to participate in and that restricts rent and rent increases.
- (4) This section applies notwithstanding the provisions of any home rule charter.
  - (5) Any ordinance in violation of this section is null and void.
