## LEGISLATIVE BILL 1057

Approved by the Governor January 19, 1972
Introduced by William P. Swanson, 27th District

AN ACT to amend section 37-214.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1969, relating to fish and game; to harmonize the provisions with previous legislation; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 37-214.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1969, be amended to read as follows:

37-214.01. (1) Any person in the military service of the United States, regardless of residence, who has been ordered to active duty at any facility of the Department of Defense or its component services located in the State of Nebraska, may hunt, fish or trap on the appropriate resident permit upon satisfactory proof that such person has been actually present for duty at such facility for a period of thirty days or more.

- (2) Any person enrolled and in actual attendance as a full-time student in any university, college, junior college, or vocational technical school college in this state, regardless of residence, may hunt or fish on the appropriate resident permit upon satisfactory proof that such person has been actually in attendance at any such institution for a period of thirty days or more.
- (3) Any person duly enrolled in the Civilian Conservation Centers or any similar governmental work or training facility in this state may hunt or fish on the appropriate resident permit upon proof that such person has been in attendance at such facility thirty days or more.
- Sec. 2. That original section 37-214.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1969, is repealed.
