

LEGISLATIVE BILL 1264

Approved by the Governor April 8, 1972

Introduced by Fred W. Carstens, 30th District

AN ACT to amend section 33-109, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1971, relating to fees and salaries; to provide a fee for the register of deeds and county clerk for attaching a certificate and seal of office; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 33-109, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1971, be amended to read as follows:

33-109. The register of deeds and the county clerk shall receive for recording a deed, mortgage, release, or any other instrument, a fee of three dollars per page; recording and indexing of a will, a fee of six dollars; recording and indexing of a decree in a testate estate, a fee of nine dollars; Provided, that when the will or decree exceeds five pages, an additional fee of three dollars per page for each page more than five pages. The cost for a certified copy of any instrument filed or recorded in the office of county clerk or register of deeds shall be one dollar and fifty cents per page. The fee for adding a certificate and seal shall be fifty cents.

Sec. 2. That original section 33-109, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1971, is repealed.
