LEGISLATIVE BILL 310

Approved by the Governor March 23, 1971

AN ACT relating to public power; to provide that public power districts and public power and irrigation districts shall not be required to post bond for costs, appeal, supersedeas, injunction or attachment.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. No bond for costs, appeal, supersedeas, injunction or attachment shall be required of any public power district or public power and irrigation district organized or created pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 70, article 6, Reissue Revised statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and amendments thereto or of any officer, board, head of any department, agent or employee of such public power district or public power and irrigation district in any proceeding or court action in which the public power district or public power and irrigation district or any officer, board, head of department, agent or employee is a party litigant in its or his official capacity.
