

LEGISLATIVE BILL 811

Approved by the Governor April 30, 1971

Introduced by P. J. Morgan, 4th District

AN ACT relating to game and fish; to provide protection for the homing pigeon as prescribed; to provide for violation; and to provide penalties.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Any person other than the owner thereof, who shall knowingly shoot, kill, maim, or injure any Antwerp or homing pigeon, commonly called Carrier Pigeon, or who shall entrap, catch, detain, or shall remove any mark, band or other means of identification from such pigeon, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined for each offense not less than ten dollars and not more than twenty-five dollars.
