LEGISLATIVE BILL 822

Approved by the Governor May 12, 1971

AN ACT to amend section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to labor; to provide for an increase in the compensation for judges of the Court of Industrial Relations; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

48-806. The As soon as such compensation may be legally paid under the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, the compensation of the judges of the Court of Industrial Relations shall be fifty seventy-five dollars per day for each day's time actually engaged in the performance of the duties of their office. Each judge shall also be paid his necessary traveling expenses incurred while away from his place of residence upon business of the court.

Sec. 2. That original section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
