LEGISLATIVE BILL 276

AN ACT to amend section 16-241, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to cities of the first class; to eliminate restrictions relating to cemetery control; to repeal the original section, and also section 12-205, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 16-241, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

16-241. A city of the first class may purchase, hold, and pay for, in the manner herein provided, lands not-exceeding-eighty-acres-in-one-body,-outside-the timits-of-the-city, for the purpose of the burial of the dead, and all necessary grounds for hospital grounds and waterworks, and have and exercise police jurisdiction over the same, and over any cemetery lying near said city and used by the inhabitants thereof.

Sec. 2. That original section 16-241, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also section 12-205, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
