

LEGISLATIVE BILL 577

Approved by the Governor May 25, 1973

Introduced by Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, Waldron, 42, Chmn.; Cavanaugh, 9; Carpenter, 48; Mahoney, 5; Skarda, 7; F. Lewis, 45

AN ACT relating to metropolitan utilities districts; to authorize such districts to construct public off-street parking facilities within designated civic centers in conjunction with the administrative headquarters of such districts; and to provide for financing.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. A metropolitan utilities district is hereby authorized to own, purchase, construct, equip, and operate public off-street motor vehicle parking facilities on property owned or leased by such district within the area designated as the civic center by the city council in the master plan of a city of the metropolitan class. Such parking facilities shall be constructed upon land contiguous to the office or administrative headquarters of such district and shall be used in whole or in part in connection therewith.

Sec. 2. Such district shall have authority to issue bonds and evidences of indebtedness for the purposes of acquiring, purchasing, constructing, and equipping such parking facilities as provided in section 14-1029, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, for other public utilities under its control, and shall have authority to manage the funds of such parking facilities and to borrow money as provided by section 14-1104, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, for other utilities.
