AN ACT to amend section 39-685, Revised Statutes
Supplement, 1973, relating to highways; to
restrict a prohibition against hunting
predatory animals; to prohibit certain
actions; to repeal the original section; and
to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-685, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, be amended to read as follows:

39-685. No person shall hunt, trap, or molest any wildlife-or-fish predatory animal on or upon any portion of a highway freeway or approach or exit thereto except at locations designated for such purpose. No person shall shoot from the roadway onto or across the land of any farmer or landowner or kill, attempt to kill, or retrieve any wildlife or game on such land prior to receiving permission from such farmer or landowner.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-685, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
