SPEAKER: Are there other nominations? Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: If there are no other nomination I move they be closed, if there is anybody who wants to nominate somebody -

SPEAKER: It's been moved that the nominations cease and Senator Schmit be declared the unanimous consent of this body as Chairman of the Agriculture and Environment Committee. Question has been called for, everybody in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carries. Now we shall proceed with the selection of the Chairman of the Appropriations Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President I have a motion to nominate Senator Marvel as Chairman of the Appropriations Committee, signed Senator Clark.

SPEAKER: Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: I think that motion speaks for itself, a man that's had this job for 10 years, I think he would be certainly well qualified and I'm happy to put his name in nomination.

SPEAKER: Are there any other nominations? We shall next proceed to election of the Standing Committee Chairman of Banking Commerce and Insurance. Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President I nominate Senator Duis.

SPEAKER: Are there any other nominations? Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: I would move the nominations close and Senator Duis be declared by acclamation.

SPEAKER: There is a motion before the house, Senator Barnett did you have another nomination?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes I did, I didn't get up too fast, but I'm here.

SPEAKER: Senator Clark will you withdraw your motion? Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, member of the Legislature I would like to nominate for the Chairmanship of Banking Commerce and Insurance, the name of Senator Fred Carstens, from Beatrice.

SPEAKER: Are there any other nominations? Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: I would renew my motion now to close the nominations vote by secret ballot.

SPEAKER: It's been moved that we close the nominations and then vote by secret ballot, everybody in favor say aye, opposed no. We shall proceed by secret ballot. Senator Duis and Senator Carstens are the two nominees.
