SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Mr. Chairman I move that nominations close and we elect Senator Syas by acclamation.

SPEAKER: It has been moved that the nominations cease and we vote for Senator Syas by acclamation. It has been seconded, everybody in favor say aye, opposed no. Senator Syas has been elected Chairman of the Standing Committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation. The next proceed to elect the Chairman of the Education Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President I have a motion to nominate Senator Keyes to Chairman of the Education Committee signed by Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President and members of the body it gives me a great deal of honor to nominate Senator Orval Keyes for Chairmanship of the Education Committee, I have served with him on an interim study committee and I know how interested and dedicated he is in educational concerns for the state and I know he represents an area of concern in his own district and I think he would do well for the citizens of the state and the senate both, and I nominate Senator Keys for this post.

SPEAKER: Senator Keyes has been nominated are there any other nominations? Senator Cal Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. Speaker, member of the legislature, I would like to place the name of Senator Jerry Warner for the Chairman of the Education Committee, he has served several sessions on the education committee, has been Chairman of the Interim Study Committee on State Aide, he has been speaker of our Legislature, Chairman of the Education Committee, Chairman of the Government and Military Affairs Committee, has been very active in legislative ideas relative to education, and I believe he is well qualified to act in this capacity. I believe that he will act with firmness and with consideration with everyone concerned.

SPEAKER: Are there any other nominations? Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Inaudible.

SPEAKER: It's been moved and seconded that the nominations cease and that we vote by secret ballot. Everybody in favor say aye, opposed no. It's been carried. Will the tellers proceed with the ballots. Is there anybody who does not have a ballot, will you please raise your hand. I see no hands. Have you all turned in your ballots? They've all been turned in. Will the clerk count the votes.

CLERK: Mr. President 30 votes for Senator Warner and 18 for Senator Keyes.

SPEAKER: Senator Warner has been elected as Chairman of the Standing Committee of Education. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: (nothing)

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter says he wishes not to be recorded as voting, is that what I understood you to say, oh to be recorded as voting. Will the clerk take note of that please. Nominations for Standing Committee Chairman Government and Military and Veteran's Affairs.

CLERK: Mr. President I move to nominate the name of Senator Stull as Chairman of Government Military Affairs, signed Senator Stromer.

SENATOR STROMER: Mr. Speaker and fellow members, I think the motion speaks for itself, Senator Stull has had a wide background in the fact that he has been involved in county government prior to his entrance to the state legislature and I think that some of this background knowledge could be put to good use as Chairman of Government Military Affairs Committee.
