SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President I rise to place a nomination in the name of the young man who has worked with us on the judiciary committee the last two years and who is very interested in Government affairs, I give you Earnest Chambers.

SPEAKER: Senator Carstens. We are now ready for nominations for Chairman of the Standing Committee, the Judiciary Committee. Senator Carstens.

SENATOR CARSTENS: Mr. President, I place in nomination Senator Luedtke, for Chairmanship of the Judiciary Committee, he has served on this in the past four years, I believe, and at the present time and for the past year or two we have been engaged extensive hearings on penal reform and related matters and I think that it should be continued, and I believe he is well qualified to preside as Chairman.

SPEAKER: Senator Luedtke has been nominated are there further nominations? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, to Mr. Luedtke I want to second the nomination, I think he has done a marvelous job, I sincerely hope he has much success and at this time I don't think there were any more nominations coming I'd say they be closed.

SPEAKER: I see no further Senators standing up. It has been moved that the nominations cease and the Chair would intertain that Senator Duis include in his motion that we proceed to do so, take a vote by acclamation. Senator Duis so does. Everybody in favor of Senator Duis' Chairman of the Judiciary Standing Committee, say aye, opposed no. Senator Luedtke has been elected. Excuse me I should have made the motion, maybe we should do that over. Everybody in favor of Senator Luedtke as being Chairman of the Judiciary Committee say aye, opposed no. Senator Luedtke has been elected as Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. And now proceed for nominations for the Chairman of the Labor Committee. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President I nominate Senator Maresh.

SPEAKER: Senator Maresh has been nominated, are there any further nominations. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I'd like to second the nomination with the hope and believe that this begin the formation of a strong farmer labor party in Nebraska.
