**SPEAKER:** Are there further nominations? Senator Fred Carstens will you turn off your light please. Senator Chambers.

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Mr. Speaker of the Legislature there apparently being no further nominations, I move that they be closed and Senator Maresh be proclaimed Chairman of this Committee by acclamation.

**SPEAKER:** It has been moved that we elect Senator Maresh by acclamation as Chairman of the Labor Committee. Everybody in favor say aye, opposed no. Senator Maresh has been elected as Chairman of the Labor Committee. We proceed to the nominations for Chairman of Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.. Senator Lewis.

**CLERK:** Mr. President I have a nomination, nominate Senator Moylan for Chairman of Miscellaneous Subjects, signed Senator Proud.

**SPEAKER:** Did you wish to speak Senator Proud?

**SENATOR LEWIS:** I'd like to nominate Senator James Waldron for this committee.

**SPEAKER:** Senator Waldron has been nominated, are there any other nominations? Senator Luedtke.

**SENATOR LUEDTKE:** I'd just like to second the nomination of Senator Waldron, because he has been a fine chairman and that committee gets a lot of those bills that don't get to the other committees and I think we should have that continued leadership.

**SPEAKER:** Are there further nominations? The Chair would entertain a motion to vote by acclamation in favor, wait a minute, we have two people up here, so will the tellers proceed to hand out the ballots. I need a motion to cease nominations. It has been moved by Senator Stromer that we cease nominations, is there a second. Everybody in favor say aye, opposed no. Nominations closed. Does anybody need a ballot? Tellers will proceed to collect - Have all the ballots been collected? They have.

**CLERK:** Mr. President 30 votes for Senator Waldron, 18 for Senator Moylan.

**SPEAKER:** Senator Waldron has been elected as Chairman of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. We now proceed for nominations for Chairman of the Public Health and Welfare.

**CLERK:** Mr. President I have a motion to nominate as Public Works Chairman, Senator Stromer, signed Senator Marvel, I'm sorry, Public Health and Welfare.

**SPEAKER:** Senator Lewis.

**SENATOR LEWIS:** Mr. Chairman I'd like to place a nomination in the name of Senator Tom Kennedy. I've served as vice chairman of this committee for the past two sessions, I think he has done an excellent job and I'd certainly endorse him as a chairman.

**CLERK:** Mr. President 30 votes for Senator Kennedy and 18 for Senator Skarda.
