CHIEF JUSTICE WHITE: Do you solemnly swear that you will support the constitution of the United States and the constitution of the State of Nebraska and that you will faithfully discharge the duties as a member of the Nebraska Public Service Commission according to the best of your ability, and that at the election at which you were chosen to fill said office, you have not improperly influenced in any way the vote of any elector and have not accepted nor will you accept or receive, directly or indirectly, any money or other valuable things from any corporation, company or person or any promise of office for any official act or influence and do you further solemnly swear that you are, not directly or indirectly interested in any common carrier, subject to the provisions of the law nor in the bond, stock, mortgages, securities, contracts or earnings of any such common carrier and that you will to the best of your ability faithfully and justly execute and enforce the duties revolving upon you as such commissioner.

SPEAKER: We will now proceed with the swearing in of the honorable Leslie Boslaugh, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court.

CHIEF JUSTICE WHITE: Do you solemnly swear that you will support the constitution of the United States and the constitution of the State of Nebraska and that you will faithfully discharge the duties of Justice of the Supreme Court according to the best of your ability, and that at the election at which you were chosen to fill said office, you have not improperly influenced in any way the vote of any elector and have not accepted nor will you accept or receive, directly or indirectly, any money or other valuable things from any corporation, company or person or any promise of office for any official act or influence.

SPEAKER: We will now proceed with the swearing in of the honorable Harry Spencer, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court.

CHIEF JUSTICE WHITE: Read, same as above.

SPEAKER: Will the committee of senators now escort the Supreme Court Justices from the chamber and to the Governor's Suite. Mr. Sergeant at Arms will you please escort Judge Wiles from the Chamber.
