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in itself would tell us something, but I think we are missing sight of the most important situation of all, I think of the citizens and the Legislature, both in the state are woefully inadequately informed on many of the problems of the state and yet we devote very little money to programing to ETV so that they can send teams out into the state and do programs on the shrinking water table in one county and the problems of schools in another county, and on and on and on. I think they not only need to know something about what is going on in the legislature, I think we all need to know the problems in the state and so far we haven't seen fit to vote ETV the money to put on adequate programing to tell about these problems. If we are going to go this far I'd like to see us go all the way and vote them a budget where they can do an intelligent job to make the people informed of the problems of the state.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President and members of the body I thought we had haggled this out pretty well in the Legislative Council today, but apparently we haven't. I'm still opposed to the idea of the legislature trying to tell ETV whether you're going to be here one day or five days or no days, I thought the purpose of ETV was primarily to allow students to train in the arts of television, it is of course to broadcast public service programs those of which aren't normally carried on through the private stations, I'm just opposed to the idea of the legislature trying to take in to it's own hands and tell ETV that you are going to have this whether you want it or not, then likewise telling the people of Nebraska that whether you like it or not, the legislature collectively has decided that this is in your best interests and the image thing of course is what I've tried to be most concerned about, although, along. I spoke last week to a hundred and forty ladies at the Welcome Wagon of Omaha, none of them had been in the state more than a year, I understand, and I didn't talk about my bills, I talked about the legislature the unicameral form of government, what I thought of it, it's good, it's bad, etc., and I think that unless this legislature collectively will carry on a similar pattern, that you're never going to have any different vote results than what you saw last fall as Senator Carstens pointed out. I'm very concerned about public relations as far as the legislature and I think that our public image here this morning is not unlike what has been seen on past programs, it'll be shown over ETV, I think that unless it is properly explained, a person turns on the ETV program with the unicameral for the first time and they say, well do they act that way all the time, so as Senator Lewis pointed out over exposure can undo something as well as exposure. If you don't use your exposure to your best extent, you're killing yourself rather than helping your image, and I personally don't think that I want to see five days of this activity rerun unless there is a way of adequately explaining to the people the why's, and the wherefore's behind some of our arguments here. I would like to renew my request to the legislature, I won't make a motion if you people who have been on the opposing sides of this issue leading it want to go ahead, my personal liking would be to have a committee appointed because I don't think the public broadcasters are going to take a half hour of our program and put it on the air, as I told you in December, any news man with integrity does not want to be given a hand out product, that's exactly what we would be giving him. If they can't do it they don't want it. It's a matter of integrity. I still would like to see a committee of the legislature I don't care who is on it, some of the things you would have to work with would be maybe ETV people themselves, but they can get out here and talk to your state broadcasters and see what they think of it. I think you'll find I can't speak for them I haven't talked to them that much and I'm not in the power to do so. I think you'll find you'll be lucky if you find one commercial station that is ready to take your half hour product.
