SPEAKER: Senator, I heard two things. One, you are asking apparently for suspension of the Rules. Second, you are asking that you have permission to withdraw the Resolution.

SENATOR KEYES: I would like to have (inaudible)suspension of the rules to have permission to withdraw this Resolution.

SPEAKER; What is your pleasure, Senator?

SENATOR KEYES: I would like to have just unanimous consent that if it does not have 30 signatures on it that I withdraw, that it be handed back to me at the end of the day, at the end of this session.

SPEAKER: How are you going to do that when you decide whether it has 30 signatures or not?

SENATOR KEYES: Ok then. OK.

SPEAKER: Are we ready for the consideration of bills on Select File? Senator Savage, did you wish to be recognized? Just trying out your button. Senator Cavanaugh, are you ready back there with consideration of the bills on Select File.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: No, I am not. No, I am not, Mr. President.
