SENATOR CARPENTER: As I tried to explain I have reason to believe that a Senator will make the motion to return the two bills for a public hearing. If that is so then it would seem to me that as soon as we set the hearing up, the sooner we'll consider and dispose of the new bills. I have no desire to circumscribe what Senator Goodrich has in mind, but if what I say is true and it will develop, I presume, it'll develop tomorrow as well as today, because there is no way to keep it from being referred to a committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I certainly have no objection whatsoever to sending them to committee for public hearing. If that's the purpose of what you had in mind, then it's perfectly alright with me. I'd love to see both of them have public hearings?

SPEAKER: Are you with-drawing your objection then?

SENATOR GOODRICH: As long as that is where they are going to go.

SPEAKER: Well I don't think the chair can determine - alright Senator Skarda.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Alright I'll with-draw the objection.

SENATOR SKARDA: I move that both bills be returned to the committee for public hearing Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I've talked to Lillian Anderson, head of the Cosmologist' Division of the State of Nebraska and there is some controversy in LB 5 and so to everybody's satisfaction I think that the best thing that we can do is to return both bills back to the proper prospectus and let everybody know what is included in them.

SPEAKER: Thank you Senator Skarda, the first thing we have to do is get the bills before us and then we can take your action. Once again are there objections to taking up LB 5 and 7 on general file at this time? Hearing no objections it is so ordered, we will take up the bills.

SENATOR SKARDA: Both to be assigned to committee for public hearing.

SPEAKER: I'm sorry Senator Skarda I didn't hear you.

SENATOR SKARDA: I move that they both be assigned to committee for public hearing.

SPEAKER: The motion is to assign both bills to committee for public hearing, is there need for discussion of that motion. Senator Marsh did you wish to be recognized? Is there any further discussion of the motion? All those in favor say aye, those opposed, wait a minute we need a machine vote on that one. All those in favor of referring them to a committee for hearing please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Once again have you all voted. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, Mr. President on the motion to return.

SPEAKER: So ordered, the motion carries. Any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President we have a motion to confirm the appointments made by the executive board to the telecommunications committee. These appear in the legislative journal for yesterday appear on page 125 of the legislative journal. Read.

SPEAKER: Very good, the Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.
