SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I was just going to say, mention I believe the rules committee had a meeting, Senator Duis had scheduled a meeting for next Monday in any event at least my book indicates that. So it is quite possible that the rules changes that Senator Carpenter proposes could be taken up next Monday, as I believe there is a meeting scheduled already, unless you want to wait longer than that, but Senator Duis had planned for such a meeting.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter, would you care to respond?

SENATOR CARPENTER: You're talking about next Monday.

SENATOR WARNER: Yeah.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I have no objection, I will not be here and that's not necessary, I brought up the question, I brought up the problem and the rules committee is qualified and competent to make a determination, and I would suggest other members who have any interest in the matter ought to appear at Monday. I will not be hear for obvious reasons, but I have no objections taking up these two suggestions, Monday and not being there, I think that is a good idea.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Senator Warner, are you all through? Very good. The Rule Change will be referred to the Rules Committee, do we have any other rules changes on the desk? The Chair recognizes Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, and fellow members, I don't like to, when I'm in a game I don't like to have the rules changed when the game is partly over, we make, I think we should make these rules at the beginning and leave them stick until we are through with this session, then change them for the next session. This changing the rules after the game is started to me, is not quite ethical.

SPEAKER: Senator Cavanaugh; do you want to possibly handle the two bills on select file?

CLERK: Mr. President there was one more announcement, the Executive Board will hold a meeting at 1:30 in room 2202 of the Legislative Council Hearing Room and Public Works will meet in 2227, rather than the Legislative Council Hearing Room for their public hearing today.

SPEAKER: Senator Syas will you turn off your white light. Thank you. Senator Carstens would you punch off your white light for me. Thank you. Ready for the consideration for LB 1 on select file?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Yes Mr. President I move that the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 1.

SPEAKER: The motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 1, all those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move that LB 1 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: Motion to advance LB 1 as amended to E & R for engrossment, all those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered the bill is amended as advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move for the adoption of the amendments E & R amendments to LB 82.

SPEAKER: Motion to adopt the amendments to LB 82, is there any further discussion. All those in favor of the motion please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered the amendments are adopted.
