SPEAKER: You have heard a motion to adopt the amendments to LB 16. All those in favor say aye, those opposed no. They stand adopted. Now what will you do with the bill?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 16 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: It has been moved that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The bill stands advanced. Are there any motions to reconsider, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Anything further on the clerk's desk at this moment?

CLERK: Nothing, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Mr. President, and members of the body, I request unanimous consent to withdraw LB 211. To explain this a little bit, Senator Snyder has a bill that I think will take care of this bill plus two or three others that can be incorporated into one bill and I think it would expedite the matter.
