SPEAKER: Senator Savage the Chair would concur with you but the rules do state that an individual vote on each one of these should be taken. I'm as interested in saving, excuse me the Chair is as interested in saving time as you are and you -

SENATOR SAVAGE: I served on this committee and we did it that way last year, I don't know what, has it been changed the rules.

SPEAKER: We did the same thing last year, yes sir and the year before that.

SENATOR SAVAGE: No, we did not.

SPEAKER: If you care to suspend the rules and do that fine, the Chair can entertain that motion, if that would be your wish? Senator Whitney how many more names do you have to be considered.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President there is one more name.

SPEAKER: Do you want to suspend -

SENATOR WHITNEY: I move that the appointment of Edward M. Rowley for the Board of Parole be approved by the legislature.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion? The question is shall the appointment of Edward Rowley be approved for the Board of Parole, all those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Once again the Chair would ask if you have all voted. Voting on the appointment, confirmation of the appointment of Edward M. Rowley to the Board of Parole, all those in favor of the appointment vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Okay, the Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote taken. 33 ayes, no nays, 16 not voting.

SPEAKER: Senator Duis voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Duis voting aye. 34 ayes, no nays, 15 not voting.

SPEAKER: Thank you, the appointment is confirmed.

CLERK: That's all Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Do we have other pending motions at all?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: Good we can move the consideration of bills on general file.
