So ordered. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR KREMER: Now, Mr. Chairman, I want to yield to the introducer of the bill to explain the amendment or suggested amendment number--referred to in Section 7. Now it was stated at the time of the hearing that this material was not needed, was not needed, so I would yield to Senator Stromer to explain this amendment.

SPEAKER: Is this in substance amendment #5? Is this what you are saying? Is it a committee amendment, Senator Kremer?

SENATOR KREMER: It's a committee amendment.

SPEAKER: Thank you, alright. Senator Kremer yields the floor to Senator Stromer.

SENATOR STROMER: Mr. Chairman, I would move the adoption of committee amendment #5. I think that I will go ahead with a separate amendment, then Mr. Chairman, to take care of the problem I talked with you about. So, if we just want to go ahead and adopt the #5 as a committee amendment, I'll have another amendment to clarify the stricken matter we took out.

SPEAKER: Now the motion is to adopt amendment #5. Senator Stromer.

SENATOR STROMER: Now would you want me to go ahead and explain what we did with #5. OK, #5 is to insure the language here that we have that when this becomes an enactive law, then that we cannot begin collecting the fees until we are ready to start with the enactment date of the bill referring to putting the photograph on the license. So, we've had this trouble before with other bills where we had increased the fees but yet the fees were increased before we were actually getting the benefit of what we were doing. So, this will make this correspond to the enactment date and so that the fees cannot be collected until the enactment date. And I would move the committee amendment #5.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of amendment #5 to LB 128? All those in favor of the amendment say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted. Are there other committee amendments.

CLERK: There are no further committee amendments, Mr. President. There are amendments from the introducer.

SPEAKER: Senator Nore, I had a book covering up my light here. Did you wish to--

SENATOR NORE: --implement this--the taking of the photographs and how much load we are going to put on our County treasurers (inaudible).

SPEAKER: Why don't you hold just a minute because you are still in order. We haven't explained the bill yet. Those were only the amendments now. If we have no more further committee amendments, then we are ready for Senator Stromer's argument on the bill.

SENATOR STROMER: Ok, Mr. Chairman, I think the appropriate order would be for me to move for LB 128 to be moved to E & R Initial and then should I take my amendment or is that in order?

SPEAKER: Your amendments are next in order, right.

SENATOR STROMER: OK, on amending LB 128, on Page 8, Line 6, strike section 7 and insert the following: Section 7, "The
