SENATOR NORE: I'd like to inquire if we have committee meetings tomorrow afternoon set?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: We have committee hearings set for tomorrow afternoon, it is my understanding there are committee hearings set for tomorrow afternoon. Yes sir. Have you all indicated your presence? The Clerk will record. Senator Barnett for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: I move that the call be raised.

SPEAKER: The motion is to raise the call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye, all those opposed vote no. I suppose part of this could be described as an exercise in futility. Have you all voted? This is to raise the call. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President to raise the call.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 22 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The Chair rules that the motion fails. We are now back to Senator Richendifer's motion to adjourn until 9:00 tomorrow. The question is shall we adjourn until 9:00 tomorrow, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 19 nays, 8 not voting.

SPEAKER: The next point after this place on the high jinks is that we will go ahead and debate LB 128. Senator Keyes for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KEYES: If that is the case then I move that we recess till 2:00 this afternoon.

SPEAKER: That's fine. This Chair at this time in order to be bound by a time of adjournment after all of this debate is going to declare that it will take 25 votes in order to adjourn the body, because that's the wish of the body. The Chair recognizes Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President fun is fun, I think we have fooled around long enough, I move that the Chair decide when we are going to adjourn, and that takes 25 votes.

SPEAKER: Well the, Senator Syas did you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR SYAS: Well all I was going to say after all of this going around and around the circle, let's just, I'll just renew the motion that we adjourn until 10:00 a.m. in the morning. Then we can get something done this way.

SPEAKER: The motion is to adjourn until 10:00 tomorrow, all those in favor of that motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted. The Clerk will record the vote.
