favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Now we are on General File, You will have to come down and push the button. Voting on the movement of 130 from General File to E & R, Initial. All those--if you have all voted the clerk will record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, 16 not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. The next move is to General File consideration of LB 29.

CLERK: Read title. LB 29. There are no committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Stand by. Senator Marsh. Excuse me, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is just a formality since I was the chairman of the committee before which the bill appeared. I thought I would say something first to smooth the way. There was no opposition to this bill and the testimony in favor of it was very capable and persuasive.

SPEAKER: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, this merely adds a Section to the death certificate, to the burial and transit permit which allow information regarding service on the permit. The purpose of this is to be sure that any veteran will have a proper burial regardless of the family situation, so that the various persons involved will immediately know what provisions are provided. Sometimes a family when a death suddenly occurs is not aware of the assistance available to veterans. This was requested by the Veterans' organizations themselves. I move we advance LB 29 from General File to E & R, Initial.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion. If there is no discussion, are you ready for the question. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: May I ask the Senator, is there going to be an "A" bill with this.

SENATOR MARSH: The cost on this as suggested--

SENATOR CARPENTER: I don't care about cost, is there going to be an "A" bill?

SPEAKER: The question, Senator Marsh, is will there be an Appropriations bill following this.

SENATOR MARSH: Then, Mr. Carpenter, I do not know the answer.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Let me say, if there is, I want a public hearing on it.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question. The question is-- the question before the body is shall the bill be advanced to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER: I declare the bill advanced. The next move to General File is consideration of LB 33. Thank you, Senator Proud.

CLERK: Read title. LB 33. There are no committee amendments.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Rasmussen.
