CHAPLAIN: Prayer read.

SPEAKER: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President Senator Syas asked to be excused today.

SPEAKER: Are there objections, so ordered. Have you all indicated your presence. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Are there corrections for the journal?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Excellent. Any petitions or memorials?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

SPEAKER: We undoubtedly have notices of Committee Hearings or Reports.

CLERK: Read.

SPEAKER: Is that all the notices?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: All the communications? If we can clear the floor then, and get the Senators in their seats, we will begin the final reading on 141 and 253 which are scheduled for today. Please get ready for final reading. Attention please while the Clerk gives the final reading to LB 141.

CLERK: Title Read LB 141.

SPEAKER: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the final passage of LB 141. Once again the chair would inquire if you have all voted. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: Vote read. 36 ayes, no nays, 13 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Attention please, the final reading of LB 253.

CLERK: Mr. President I move to return LB 253 to select file for specific amendment to strike the enacting clause, signed Senator Carpenter.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, first I'd like to ask Senator Marvel several questions.

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel will you yield to some questions from Senator Carpenter?

SENATOR CARPENTER: This bill what is it, what's it do and what's the necessity for it?

SENATOR MARVEL: This is the bill, I guess that was explained while you were gone, and we passed out to the various legislators explanation on about eight different items. These were items that the Governor despite comments of the contrary, approved, and seemed to be the most important deficiencies that had come before us. Would you like to have me go over these?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Are they expenditures for more than they were originally authorized?
