SPEAKER: Thank you.

SENATOR BARNETT: The purpose of the Committee amendments was to clarify the language as it was stated in the original bill. Senator Duis brought up the fact that it looked like they was talking about part-time superintendents, sheriffs and attorneys and it actually is a matter of clarification so that it will refer to the--everybody except the part-time school superintendent and this is true in the four sections of the bill. It does nothing to change the intent of the bill or anything. It is just a matter of clarification in the language. I move for their adoption.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the committee amendments? All those in favor of adopting the amendments, say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted. Senator Anderson. Are there other amendments?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: LB 74 provides for a 25% increase in the minimum salary which may be paid to full time county officials in classes of counties I through V. This 25% increase is based primarily on a projected rate of inflation. The thing that needs to be realized here is that county officials salaries may only be raised once every four years. County officials salaries may only be raised at the beginning of each elective term and this is why we have to do a four year jump at one time
