CHAPLAIN: Prayer read.

SPEAKER: Roll call.

CLERK: Senator Snyder asked to be excused until he arrives Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator Simpson asked to be excused.

SPEAKER: Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Have you all indicated your presence? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Are there corrections for the journal? Excellent. Any petitions or memorials? Notices of Committee Hearings or Reports?

CLERK: Yes. Committee Reports read.

SPEAKER: While the legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am signing LB 47. Subsequent thereto LB 49, and LB 54.

CLERK: Mr. President there will be inserted in the journal a statement of cost expended for employees of the legislature for the month of January. That's all Mr. President.

SPEAKER: We are down to the item on the agenda, bills on final reading. Once again the Chair could plead with you to take your seats and we could clear the floor, we could begin final reading. I'll ask a little assistance from the Sgt. At Arms.

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman I need to be excused at 9:30 until this afternoon. I ask permission.

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer asking to be excused at 9:30 until this afternoon. Are there objections to Senator Kremer's absence, hearing none, it is so ordered. The first bill on final reading this morning will be LB 52. Once again the Chair would like to ask the Senators to please take their seats. Attention please the final reading of LB 52, the assistant Clerk will read the bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Title Read LB 52.

SPEAKER: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Once again the Chair would require if you have all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: Vote read. 43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is passed. Attention please the final reading of LB 93.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Title Read LB 93.
