SENATOR PROUD: Why certainly.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, would Senator Chambers yield to a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Certainly.

SENATOR KELLY: Senator Chambers the statement that you just made, I concur with wholeheartedly, and this is the imput that the committee did not have on this bill, whatsoever, it would be my suggestion that your imput get put in to this legislation and I probably would be able to support it wholeheartedly.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then would you help us raise it first, because right now, there is no bill any more.

SENATOR KELLY: My experience here in this limited time, is the correcting these things on the floor, it's very difficult to do. I would much prefer see this bill stay where it is, and see it bill that would satisfy the people that got to do both sides of this, from the peoples point of view, not from the Director of the Commission, Senator Chamber.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Kelly, there is no bill now.

SENATOR KELLY: I understand that, but I think that there should be a bill, in talking the way your talking, not the way the Commissioner of Equal Opportunity Commission talked.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then why don't you help us raise it, and then we can deal with the bill, it can be bracketed after it is raised, if the amendments that are needed are not adopted the same fate that it suffered in your committee it can suffer on the floor, but until it is raised up, I think it would be pointless for me to go to a lot of trouble of talking to people and try to working out amendments to a bill which does not even exist.

SENATOR KELLY: Please help me write a bill that won't have to be amended.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would ask that you raise this one.

SPEAKER: Senator Marsh do you care to close?

SENATOR MARSH: I would like to point out that when we raise this to general file, it does not mean we are passing this bill, it means that we are putting it on general file, so we can discuss it, so we have an opportunity to put the amendments that various people have indicated they feel are necessary, but until it is on general file, we can do nothing with it. Please vote to put LB 112 on general file, so we can cope with it there. Thank you.

SPEAKER: The question is shall LB 112 be placed on general file, notwithstanding the action of the committee. This requires 25 votes to bind the body. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.
