The clerk will clear the board. The question before us now is shall we have a call of the house. All those in favor of a Call of the House, vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted on a Call of the House. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes on a Call of the House.

SPEAKER: We are under a Call of the House. The issue before us, of course, is Final passage of LB 9. Would, at the next bell please, indicate your presence. With this action we are trying to determine who is here and present. Asking you to please record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Fred Carstens voting aye on the original motion. Senator Kime voting no on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Rasmussen voting no.

CLERK: Senator Rasmussen voting no on the original motion. Senator Savage voting..

SPEAKER: Senator Savage voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Savage changing from aye to no.

SPEAKER: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, am I recorded as voting at first. I voted no and I don't believe it was recorded.

CLERK: You were indicated as not voting, Senator.

SENATOR KEYES: I voted no.

CLERK: You are voting no on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Keyes voting no.

CLERK: Senator Waldron voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Stull. Senator Duis.

CLERK: Ya, I see him.

SPEAKER: Senator Stromer.

SENATOR STROMER: I call for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER: Senator Stromer is asking for a roll call vote. Senator Carpenter, we are under a Call of the House. Senator Lewis, take your seat. Senator Skarda, we are under Call of the House. Senator Simpson, for what purpose do you rise.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, as long as we're going to have a roll call vote, I move to Raise the Call.

SPEAKER: Motion is to raise the Call. All those in favor of raising the Call vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 3 nays, to raise the Call.

SPEAKER: The Call is raised. We are taking a roll call vote on LB 9.
