committee approved it only I failed to get it into the committee report, and failed to get it across as a committee amendment, it actually is a committee amendment, and we are putting it on this way. What it does on page 9, it reinserts the stricken matter that you find on page 9, which deals with professional corporations and that matter must be retained in here, because it must accept the secretary and the assistant secretary and that it inserts on page 12, line 13, the reference to 21-2209 which has to be included in order to make consistency professional corporation act in the state of Nebraska.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the amendment? The question is shall the Luedtke amendment be adopted, all those in favor of adopting the amendment please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered the amendment is adopted. Senator Luedtke we are back to your 157 as amended.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Now, Mr. President I move that LB 157 be advanced to E&R for review as amended. Mr. President and members of the legislature, as I have already mentioned to you, this is the bill, it seems that every section, we have a few matters which have to be taken up with regard to our corporation laws which are voluminous and which are constantly changing because of uniform action throughout the United States. The actions, that have been taken in the interim here in even a years time and by way of some remedial legislation effecting bills which we have already passed in years gone by, effect only a few sections of the law, I think about five or six sections of the law, and I would just very quickly go over them. Section 1 on page 2, then section 21-2002, to revise the section regarding registered agents so that it complies with 21-2011, which already describes that office, so that's what that does. It's inconsistent in other words, and so that will make it consistent. Section 2, on page 5, deletes the paragraph 21-20,107, because it imposes upon the state of Nebraska, something which it cannot even do, because it says you've got to have foreign corporations have the certain corporate words which if they aren't in their foreign corporation laws they can't be in Nebraska, because we have to accept them as they come from Missouri, or Colorado, or South Dakota wherever it is, so that's the reason for that one. Section 3, on page 6, would amend section 21-20, 113, deletes the last paragraph because it's actually superfluous, the forms they file stated that the change was authorized by resolution and the forms must be signed by the president, therefore, there is no need for the register, agent to submit a copy of such a statement, so this is just getting rid of some unnecessary red tape and any time we can do that it's well that we do so. Section 4, on page 9 of the bill, amends section 21-2216. This is in order that this section and the professional corporation may comply with the Nebraska Business Corporation Act, in that providing that the certificate from the regulating board must be filed when the articles of incorporation are filed with the secretary of the state. This causes less suspensions and less administrative procedure, again cutting red tape, and then that was the one incidently where there was an amendment which we just adopted. Then section 5, on page 11, amends section 21-2217, to add to this section, things taken from another section which again is a consistency matter and it almost can be considered in the nature of a revisor's bill, in fact the revisor should have put it in the revisor's bill, and then section 6, page 12, repealed chapter 21 article 18, because of the fact that it is obsolete, it's antiquated, it's also inconsistent with the present professional corporation act and therefore should be eliminated from the statutes entirely.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the bill? Question, Senator Waldron did you wish to be recognized? The question is shall LB 157 be advanced from general file to E&R initial, all
