I'll be happy to slow down my motion. Therefore, Mr. President, I withdraw my motion in favor of the suggestion of Senator Carpenter hoping that there will be some more discussion.

SPEAKER: Senator Fellman is asking unanimous consent to withdraw his motion to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment, that be to strike the enacting clause. The question now is are there any objections to that motion,

SENATOR SYAS: The only thing about it is..No, I'm not objecting, but Senator Fellman says "so there will be more discussion". It's on Final Reading. The only way you can discuss it is with his motion. How can he discuss it otherwise? You cannot discuss a bill on Final Reading unless you have a motion to bring it back to Select File. So, how.. I just wish to ask the question of the Senator, how is he going to discuss if he withdraws his motion?

SPEAKER: All right. Senator Fellman, Senator Syas is essentially correct and that is that the bill can't be discussed, of course, on Final Reading. It has to be returned to some other phase in order to be debated this way and go ahead, Senator Fellman, do you care to respond?
