go to LB 252. The Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Title Read LB 252. The title had been read Mr. President, the bill was advanced to general file without a committee amendment and then the Carpenter amendment was adopted, inserting the word land, and the Whitney amendment was adopted, inserting undeveloped and there is pending Senator Dickinson's amendment to strike fifty and insert forty.

SPEAKER: Instead of work committee amendments?

CLERK: Well everything has been adopted except the Dickinson amendment which is now pending, striking fifty and inserting forty acres of land.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Would the Clerk repeat immediately prior discussion please, I was doing something else and missed part of it.

SPEAKER: Very good. We have, all we have before the body now on LB 252 is your amendment and the Clerk will read the amendment again please.

CLERK: Amendment read.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Is that the way the amendment now stands?

CLERK: Well as amended by the Whitney amendment which struck the word undeveloped, so your amendment is now pending which would strike fifty and insert forty acres.

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich for what purpose do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR GOODRICH: To question the Clerk for a second?

SPEAKER: Okay.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. Clerk we had an amendment by Mr. Carpenter, Senator Carpenter excuse me, amending the Dickinson amendment which in essence struck all of line 4 and took out all the reference to mileage, what happened to that motion?

CLERK: Took out reference to what sir?

SENATOR GOODRICH: To line 4.

CLERK: Well the Carpenter amendment delted all of line 4, this was adopted, it's on the bill.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Right.

CLERK: Strike all of the Dickinson amendment as amended by the Whitney amendment and that was adopted. Then the Whitney amendment delted reference to undeveloped land, that was adopted, so now you go back to the Dickinson amendment which strikes fifty and inserts forty which is still pending.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well didn't the Carpenter amendment eliminate all reference to acreage at all? I'll think you'll find that's the case.

CLERK: Well it says strike the Dickinson amendment, as amended by the Whitney amendment.
