SPEAKER: Well there are objections to withdraw the amendment so we still have before the body an amendment to the Barnett amendment, and so that's the question, the question now is we'll vote on the amendment to whether it will be adopted or not. We now before the body the Barnett amendment, does anybody else wish to speak on that? Senator Waldron did you wish to speak on the issue? The Question is shall the Barnett amendment be adopted, all those in favor will vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the Barnett amendment, to LB 197, whether it will be adopted or not all those in favor vote aye, those opposed, you are voting on the Barnett amendment, all those in favor of the Barnett amendment vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Now then have you all voted. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 27 nays, 18 not voting.

SPEAKER: That just disposes of the Barnett amendment. Now the Chair understands that Senator Syas is attempting to ask for your unanimous consent to withdraw his name from the bill so that Senator Carpenter's name could be added to the bill, how many names are on the bill now?

CLERK: Just one.

SPEAKER: If we withdraw your name the bill will be without a sponsor, so we will have to

SENATOR SYAS: Draw mine, I'll extend him that courtesy, or let Senator Barnett put his name on too, or anybody else.

SPEAKER: Such unanimity.

SENATOR SYAS: I just want off this horse.

SPEAKER: Very good, Senator, now then the chair would like to recognize Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask unanimous consent that my name be placed on the bill.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter is ask-, Senator Duis for purpose do you rise? Do you object to Senator Carpenter's name on the bill?

SENATOR DUIS: Not at all, except that I think we had better do it properly and suspend the rules first because, there is a ten bill limit, we suspend the rules and I'll be happy to vote for the suspension of the rules, then it can be done by unanimous consent.

SPEAKER: The Chair appreciates your motion, and the suggestion, the question is shall the rules be suspended, and Senator Carpenter's name added to LB 197 at this time, all those in favor vote aye, Senator Cal Carsten, did you wish to be recognized?
