SENATOR CAL CARSTEN: Mr. President, if we are going to suspend the rules, just to do this, for heavens sake I've only got nine bills, I'm entitled to one more and I don't believe, we suspend the rules too damn much anyhow. Let's forget it and I'll take the bill with unanimous consent and we won't have to suspend the rules, I'm still eligible for it.

SPEAKER: Well stand by, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I want to ride it to death.

SPEAKER: The Chair is going to rule that the suspension of the rules is not necessary, that the 10 days is passed anyway in this particular instance, the question is are there objections to the addition of Senator Carpenter's name to this bill? Any objections, Hearing none so ordered, Senator Carpenter's name is added to LB 197, now Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: Now I ask unanimous consent to take my name off. Thank you.

SPEAKER: Are there objections to Senator Syas' removal of his name, hearing none so ordered. Now we are back to 197, now Senator Carpenter's bill, do we have any other amendments on the bill?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter we are back to you, with LB 197, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Let me ask Senator Barnett a question.

SPEAKER: Senator Barnett will you yield?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes.

SENATOR CARPENTER: If I understood you right, you intend to attempt to amend the bill by having your amendment perfected so it will do what you apparently plan to do, is that right?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Will you be in a better position to hold the bill in front of select file?

SENATOR BARNETT: I think it would be alright Senator, it still requires 25 votes, or lets see if I'm right now, on, it can't be adopted on general file by the majority couldn't it?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

SENATOR BARNETT: And it will take 25 on select wouldn't it? What's that, I'll take that chance.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I only want to be generous gentlemen, because

SENATOR BARNETT: I appreciate that.

SENATOR CARPENTER: this is a good bill, and I think it has possibilities in other areas, so I know move that this bill be advanced to E&R for initial.

SPEAKER: The motion is to advance LB 197 from general file to E&R initial, is there a need for further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 197 be advanced from general file to E&R initial, Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: A point of information Mr. President.
