On Page 4, line 9, after the "carried" insert "No meeting of the Board shall be held at any time except on the call of the Chairman of the Board". Add a new section 5 and emergency clause. Now, this particular corrections of the original bill was to correspond with the city or metropolitan and to give them the chance to have a Board that would be active and do what is requested for licensing. I would move that this amendment as stated in the book would be added to LB 103.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the committee amendments as explained by Senator Kennedy? Any further discussion? The question is shall the committee amendments be adopted? All those in favor say aye. All right. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The committee amendments are adopted. Are there any other amendments to the bill. Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Kennedy has saved me the trouble of explaining the bill. All it does is assure a quorum for the Board in Omaha and I move that the bill be advanced to E & R Initial with the amendments.

SPEAKER: Are there any other amendments on the desk for the bill?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, in the committee amendments it says that no meeting of the Board shall be held at any time except on call of the Chairman of such Board. Now, what if this gentleman was sick or something like that and couldn't call a meeting, what would happen then. I wonder, Senator Savage, if you could answer that. I'm just wondering. Senator (??) is there a opportunity there for somebody else to call the meeting in case...

SENATOR SAVAGE: Yes, this is filled in that he can have someone else. The request comes to him but he can designate that it be called by somebody representing him.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Once again, any further discussion of the bill. The question is...Senator Duis, did you care to be recognized? Just a second. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the Irish plumbers have had a caucus over here and we support this bill.

SPEAKER: Thank you, sir. Once again, any further discussion of LB 103. The question is shall LB 103 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Once again, have you all voted? Have you all voted? I'll wait for you, Senator Warner. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, 20 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. That moves us on to the General File consideration of LB 285.

CLERK: Read title. LB 285. There are no committee amendments or other amendments pending.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Cavanaugh.
