SENATOR PROUD: Well let me ask you this, then all Senator Moylan as I understand it has to do, is to give his bill to the reference committee and then it follows the due course, isn't that correct?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR PROUD: So Senator Moylan, I think if you will give that bill to Senator Carpenter, the Chairman of the Executive Board, or Senator Mahoney, the Vice Chairman, then it will follow it's usual course and I presume it will be introduced. Please don't believe that I'm trying to interfere with your bill but we have required the others to do that.

SENATOR MOYLAN: I appreciate your information there Mr. Speaker, and I will proceed in that manner, let's see now, I suppose I could give it to any member of the Executive Board, today?

SENATOR PROUD: Senator Moylan I don't believe the Exec Board will meet today, so I suggest that Monday morning you give that to Senator Carpenter, or this afternoon if either Senator Carpenter or Senator Mahoney are here.

SENATOR MOYLAN: That will be fine then, I see Senator Mahoney is up there maybe he will take it to the Exec Board right now. Thank you.

SPEAKER: Thank you Senator Moylan. For the information of the body, this particular rule is found on page 23 and it is section 4, rule 5, section 4, yes rule 5, section 5, sub section B, and it says that the reference committee shall determine which committee of the legislature this subject of the bill is germane to and the bill shall then be submitted to the committee designated by the reference committee, having completed consideration of the proposed bill, this standing committee shall return the bill to the reference committee for approval and authorization to submit the same for introduction, and if approved by the reference committee, the bill may be introduced as provided in section 5A. Senator Keyes, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, I will explain the procedure by which I have one of my two bills introduced. I took the bill at the suggestion of the group to Senator Carpenter, Senator Carpenter and his committee gave the bill to Sue, Sue came back and gave the bill to me, I asked the committee what to do with it, and they said take it to the committee which it is relevant to, so I took one to Senator Kremer, your committee and one to Senator Warner's committee, Senator Kremer's committee asked me in, talked to me about it, they are going to introduce it, I have heard nothing from Senator Warner. So I'm batting 50% by a procedure that went to the executive board, down to Sue, back to me with the bill and nothing happened on it. It was a good four day wait.

SPEAKER: Well, are there any other bills for introduction? Excuse me, Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Well Senator Keyes if you have a bill that is still there and you need action on it, I'll take it along with Senator Moylan's and we will have a meeting between now and next Tuesday, and we will refer it to a committee, that's the procedure.

SPEAKER: Is that alright with you Senator Keyes?

SENATOR KEYES: Well at present the bill is in, it's an education bill, it is in the hands of Senator Warner, maybe Warner is going to introduce it, I don't know, but there's where it sits right now.
