

We'll lay your request over, or your motion over, Senator Rasmussen, under the rules. Stand by, Senator Cavanaugh, we have a motion up here coming in from Senator Marvel.

CLERK: Motion of Senator Marvel read.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Some place along the line I guess we got our wires crossed. The Appropriations Committee introduced L.B. 302 which is attempting to set up district or community mental health facilities. 376 is a kind of a standby bill and I assume somebody contacted me and the message didn't get through the brain cells some way so if it is possible without causing too much trouble, Vince, I have to do this with a suspension of the rules. I would like to suspend the rules which, in effect, would postpone any hearing on this bill until the committee acts on L.B. 302 because those who are interested in 376 already appeared on 302 and proposed amendments so that's the motion and I, I would hope that we can get the 30 votes to do this.

SPEAKER: O.K. Chair recognizes Senator Syas. We have before us the motion to suspend the rules--

SENATOR SYAS: I'm not going to oppose suspending the rules to do this, but on a public hearing, isn't the rule 7 days? And this is 4.

SENATOR MARVEL: That's why I have to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the motion? The question is, shall the rules be suspended and hearing cancelled? All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Senator Marvel asking for suspension of the rules or to cancel hearing on the bill. Once again the Chair would remind you that it does take 30 votes for a suspension of the rules. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Thank you, the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, 19 not voting.

SPEAKER: Motion carries.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have some committee reports.

SPEAKER: I have Senator Cavanaugh standing by. Go ahead, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 108.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the amendments to L.B. 108. All those in favor of the motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that L.B. 108 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER: You heard the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Those opposed say no. Bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 234.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the amendments to L.B. 234. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendment is adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move L.B. 234 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.
